



GETTING THERE

IF FLYING

From Brussels Zaventem Airport, you need to take the train directly to Leuven (+/- 20min.)

From Brussels South Charleroi Airport you need to

- (1) take a Flibco Bus to Brussels Midi Station (+/- 50min.)
- (2) take a train to Leuven Station (+/- 30min.)

IF TAKING THE TRAIN

Brussels Midi Station (South/Zuid) is the closest large transfer hub to catch the train to Leuven.

Take the IC train directly to Leuven (+/- 30min)

There are several ways to bypass Brussels if you are arriving from elsewhere in Europe. Please consult local train guides (https://www.belgiantrain.be/en)



Pay close attention to take the train to Leuven and **NOT** Louvain-la-Neuve. These are two different cities.

IF DRIVING

Be aware that driving within the city is difficult as most areas are accessed via the ring road. If you are driving down, there are several options for long-term parking.
